Parent's Evenings

Remembrance Poppies

As we are approaching Remembrance Day when we think about service men and women who have died in the wars, we will be selling poppies and other items such as wristbands on behalf of the British Legion, who provide lifelong support for the Armed Forces community, and their families. The poppy is a symbol of remembrance and hope, and the children are making a display of poppies on our war memorial in the hall, which we hope you will have a look at during parent's evening. Costs range from 50p for the paper poppies to £2.00 for the wristbands.

Coats

It is essential that children always have an outdoor warm waterproof coat with them in school. As with all items of clothing, please ensure their name is in it.

Nursery Applications

If you have, or know anyone, with a child born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 they will be eligible to start nursery in September 2019. Booklets are available from the school office and all applications are made online at www.eadmissions.org.uk. There is a possibility we will be able to take some three year old children early, from January 2019, providing they have turned three years old by 31 December 2018. This means their birth date would be between 1 September 2015 and 31 December 2015. If you are interested, please apply online for your nursery place as soon as possible in the next couple of weeks so that we can look into this. Priority will be given to siblings of children already attending Southbury.

Reception Applications

Reception applications are now open for children born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2015. This also includes our current Nursery children, all of whom have been given a booklet. Applications are made online at www.eadmissions.org.uk If you know anyone who is not in our nursery and requires a place please let them know.
