## **English**

We will continue to learn and practise the spelling patterns and key words for Year 5 which include: silent letters, homophones and common prefixes and suffixes.

Our core texts for this term will be The Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe by C.S. Lewis and Robin Hood.

You are expected to share a book with your child every day and sign their reading record at least once a week. Your child should be reading for 20 minutes every night. We encourage you to take your child to the library and share books regularly with them.

### **Topic**

In History, we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks exploring their daily lives, the history of the Olympics and their contribution to the modern world. We will also be having an Ancient Greek day where we will dress up as Ancient Greeks for the day and have some food tasting.
