

English

Throughout the spring term children will continue to develop speaking, listening and writing skills. These will be taught through a range of texts including Fairy Tales and non-fiction texts. They will continue to develop their understanding of grammar and punctuation, including capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.

Cursive handwriting and correct letter formation will be taught throughout the term.

Children will continue to work towards the phase 5 Letters and Sounds phonic programme to support their literacy.

Topic

In Geography we will be learning about the 4 countries that make up the United Kingdom and our local area.

In RE, we will be learning about the Hindu festival of Holi and what it is like to be part of a Muslim family.

Science

Children continue to learn about the animal kingdom; investigate their own bodies and their senses and learn about the season of winter.

PE

Pupils will be developing skills in games and gymnastics. P.E days are Mondays (Red Class) and Wednesday (Blue Class). Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school every day.

Art/D&T

Children will be developing their sketching skills through portrait work and experimenting with different media.

Homework

Please continue to read with your child, explore a range of books and question the children's understanding based on what they have read.

Music

Children will be exploring the sounds of different instruments. This will be linked to the work they are doing in Topic.

PSHE

Children will be learning to consider how their behaviour affects others. They will discuss the importance of shared rules and also learn about their bodies.

Maths

This term we will be consolidating number work to 100. Children will continue to build their understanding of the concepts of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Children will be continuing to learn and practise their 10, 2 and 5 times tables as well as their number bonds to 20 and doubles to 10. They will also develop their understanding of measurement, including time, length and height. Money, fractions and shape will be taught.

Children will receive maths homework every other week which will be related to areas covered that week in class.
