### School Discos Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> June

As you know, we are holding our school discos on Wednesday.

Please remember that Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 must bring their change of clothes with them on **Wednesday morning** please. The children must be picked up **promptly** at the end of the disco **at 4.30pm**. Infants are **not allowed** to remain with brother and sisters at the junior disco.

**The Key Stage 2 Disco is from 4.45pm-6.00pm. The children (yrs 3,4,5 & 6) must go home as usual at 3.15pm and not return to the school site until 4.40pm at the earliest.** We do not want unsupervised children in the playground before this time. The children will be given their ticket on Wednesday afternoon and must bring this with them for entry to the disco.

Please note: **NO MOBILE PHONES** or photos are allowed in the disco. If children arrive with a phone this will be taken from them for safekeeping until after the disco. **Junior children must be collected promptly at 6pm or given permission to walk home alone.**

The £3 ticket price includes a packet of crisps and a drink. Children may bring extra money for other snacks, glow sticks or Halal/Vegetarian hot dogs if you wish.

### Hot Weather

As you are aware we are experiencing a period of very hot weather. Please remember to apply sunscreen to exposed skin before your child comes to school and ensure they have a sun hat. As always they may bring a named bottle of water to school, although drinking water is, of course, available in the classrooms and playground.

### Sports Day - Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> July

This will take place as usual on Durants Park Field which is accessed from The Ride.

Morning: **Foundation Stage (Nursery & Reception) & Key Stage 2 (Y3-Y6)**

Afternoon: **Key Stage 1 (Y1&2)**

Parents are welcome to come along. We will arrive at the field at approximately 9.45am in the morning and 1.45pm in the afternoon.

Children should come to school on that day in their PE kits. They will be asked to wear their team colours and they will be told which colour this is by their class teacher.

We still have a few spaces in our nursery for next school year starting in September. If you have or know of a child who will be **3 years old by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018**, we are encouraging parents to come along to one of our open sessions on either **Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> June 9.00am - 11am** or **Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July between 1pm and 3pm**.
