### <u>English</u>

Throughout the summer term children will build on speaking, listening reading and writing skills. These will be taught through a range of texts including poetry. Children will consolidate their understanding and use of grammar and punctuation and will continue to build a wider range of interesting vocabulary.

Cursive handwriting and correct letter formation will be taught throughout the term.

Children will continue to work towards the phase 5 Letters and Sounds phonic programme to support their literacy.

#### <u>Topic</u>

In History we will be learning about Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong. In RE, we will be learning exploring Judaism.

### <u>Science</u>

We will continue learning about the seasons, focussing on Spring and Summer. We will also be investigating and learning about plants and flowers. <u>PE</u> Pupils will be developing skills in games, dance and gymnastics. P.E days are Thursdays and Fridays. Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school. Art/D&T

They will design, produce and evaluate a puppet.

# Year 1 Summer Topic Term Curriculum Map

### <u>Music</u>

Children will be exploring rhythm and beat using different instruments. This will be linked to the work they are doing in Topic.

## <u>PSHE</u>

Children will be learning about their responsibilities in school and also people who help us.

### <u>Maths</u>

This term we will be consolidating number work to 100. Children will continue to build their understanding of the concepts of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Children will be continuing to learn and practise their 10, 2 and 5 times tables as well as their number bonds to 20 and doubles to 10. They will also develop their understanding of measurement, including mass, weight, time and capacity. Money, fractions and shape will also be taught.

Children will receive maths homework every other week which will be related to areas covered that week in class.
