Religious hijabs must be plain white, black, grey or burgundy red.

✗ Children may not wear:

Slip-on shoes or High heels.



Tops that do not cover the shoulders or stomach.



Clothes with slogans across them.



Jewellery: hooped or "dangly" earrings, necklaces, rings, bracelets.
