### **English**

Building on skills learnt in year 4, we will continue to develop the children's confidence with higher level features of writing such as complex sentences, use of synonyms and developing links and connections in and between paragraphs. We will be reviewing topics missed during the summer term of year 4 such as poetry, instruction and play scripts.

We will continue to learn and practice the spelling patterns and key words for Year 5, which includes plurals, prefixes and suffixes and silent letters. We will also look at key words missed from year 4, which include homophones.

We recommend you share books with your child regularly at home. The oxford owl website, used during school closure for home learning, is still available to use online.
