Maths

This term we will be continuing to develop confidence and fluency in mental calculations involving whole numbers, counting and place value. They will also need to practise counting on in steps of. 6,7,9, 25, 1000 e.g. 6,12,18, etc. Please help your child to learn and practise these with daily chants.
