Our School Railings.

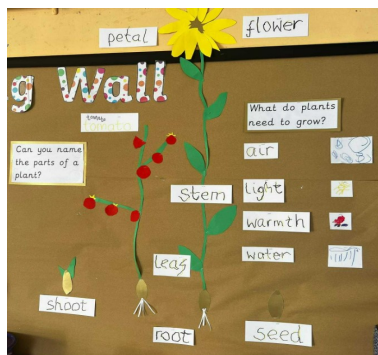

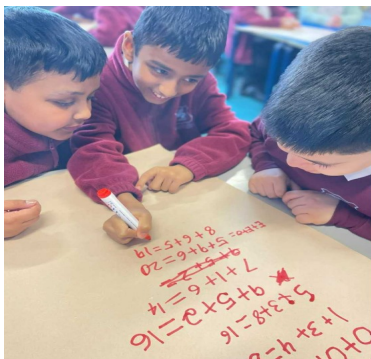
Year 2
