

### English

The topics for English this term are stories with dilemmas, non-fiction writing and poetry.

We will continue to learn and practise the statutory spellings for Years 3 & 4 so do support your child in preparing for their weekly Spelling Test.

Our core books for this term will include *Cheat!* and *Oliver and the Seawigs*.

You are expected to share a book with your child every day and sign their reading record at least once a week. We encourage you to take your child to the library and share books regularly with them.

### Topic

In Geography, we will be learning about deserts, rainforests, biomes, time zones and countries in the hemispheres and along the equator.

### Science

In Science, we will be covering topics on 'Scientists and Inventors' and 'Living Things and their Habitats'.

### Computing

The children will be taught Animation using 'Pivot Animator' and other computing techniques.

### PE

Pupils will be developing skills in Striking and Fielding games and Athletics.
