They will gain independence.

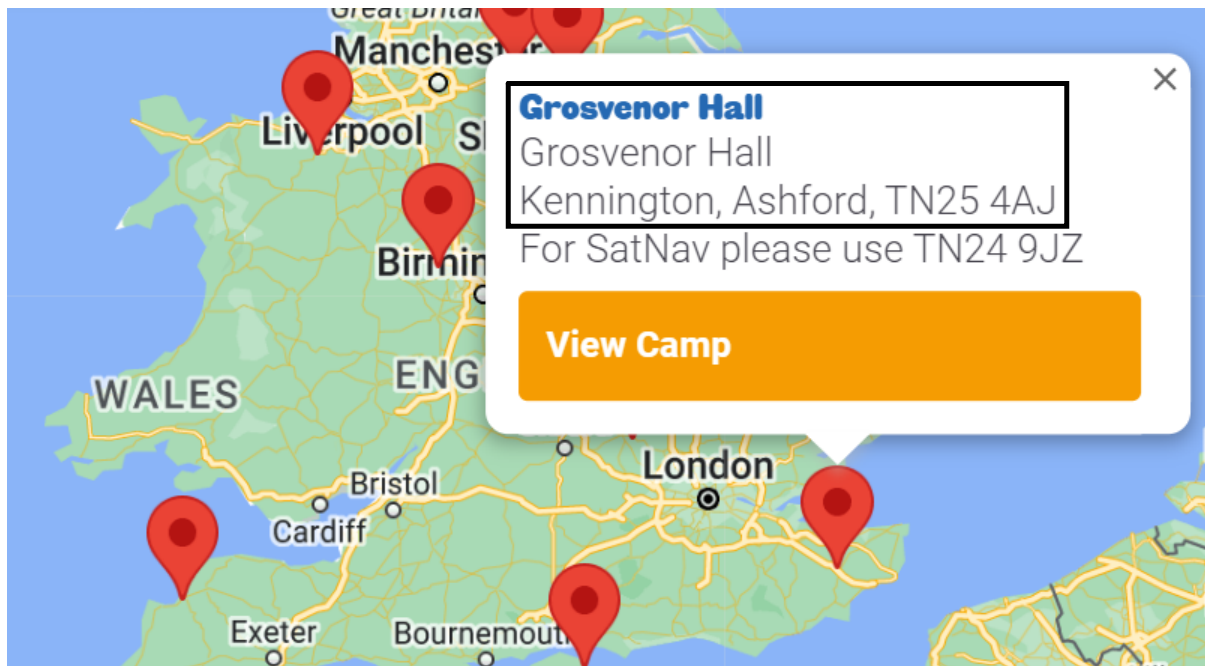
They will improve their self confidence.

The children will sleep in large bedrooms. All rooms are gender-separated.

Clean duvets and pillows are provided.

Most rooms are en-suite but there are always separate toilet and shower facilities for guests close to rooms.

The centre serves three freshly prepared, healthy, buffet-style meals each day, with plenty of variety available - including hot and cold meals, a salad bar and plenty of water available at all times.

Night-Time

School staff are available 24/7.

Teacher's rooms are clearly marked to enable easy identification at night.

PGL also have a night security team who patrol the buildings and grounds.



The grounds are gated and the only entrance or exit point is through a 24hr manned gate.

Health and Safety

- Two first aiders

- Risk assessments – no access to the general public
- Medical forms – completed before the trip
- Medication/Travel pills will be administered by first aiders each day
- Any issue with your child, you will be contacted

If you want to join us on the trip in 2026:

- Dates of trip : 9th- 13th February (4 nights)
- Cost of the trip: This is £300
- Initial, non refundable, deposit of £60 to be paid by 20th June 2025 via ParentPay.
- Four instalments of £60 to be paid in July, Sept, Oct, Nov.
