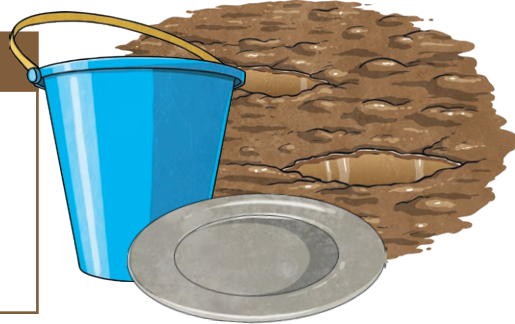

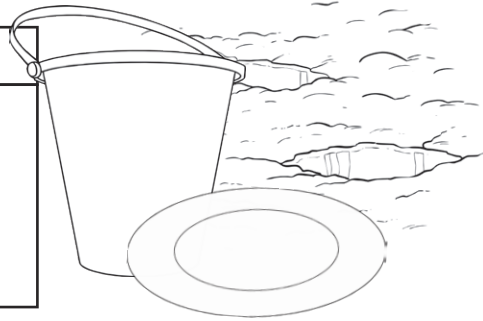

Answers
