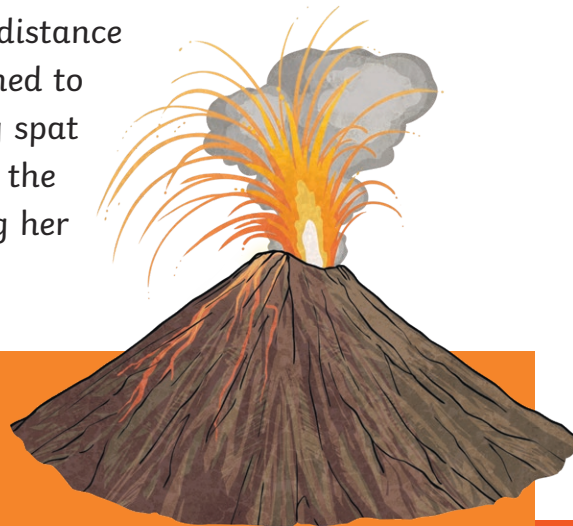


Krakatoa

3. What job do you think the narrator of the recount has? Explain your answer.



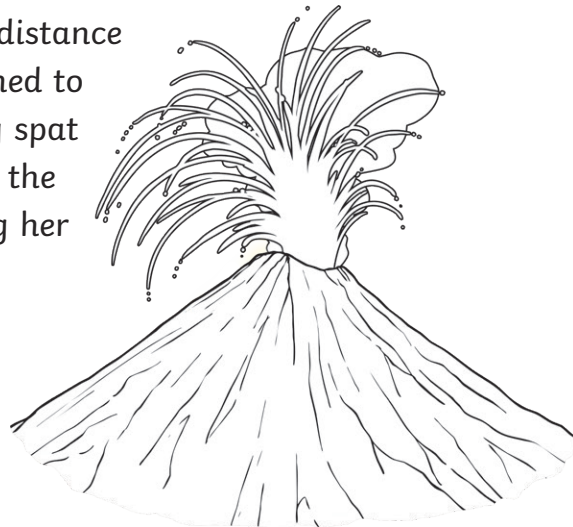

Answers
