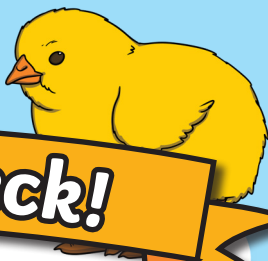
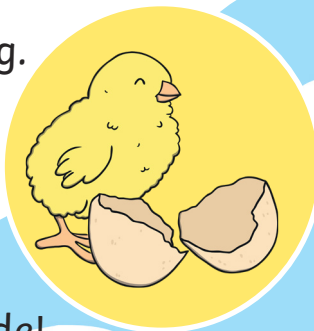


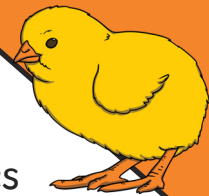
Peck, Peck, Peck!

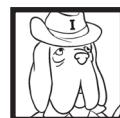
1. Write another word that rhymes with 'egg'.
