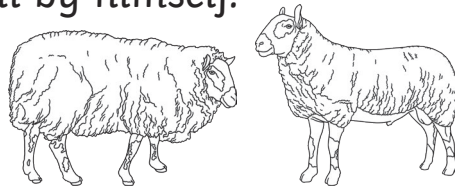

Answers



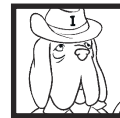
1. What are the names of the characters in this play?
