## 28 You will need:

- 35 • a wooden twig                      • colourful or sparkly wool
- 38 • paint                                      • biodegradable glitter
- 39 • glue

## 42 What to do:

- 49 1. Choose a wooden twig that has
- 53     fallen from a tree.
- 62 2. Paint the twig with any colour and allow
- 65     it to dry.
- 75 3. Coat the thickest end of the twig with glue
- 84     and wrap the wool or thread tightly around it
- 93     to make a handle. Then, allow this to dry.
- 103 4. Finally, put some glue on the thinnest end of
- 111     your new wand and dip it in some
- 115     biodegradable glitter to decorate.
- 124 5. Allow your wand time to dry completely and
- 129     then it's ready to use.

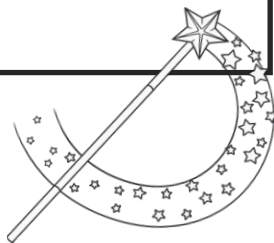

- 75 3. Coat the thickest end of the twig with glue  
84 and wrap the wool or thread tightly around it  
93 to make a handle. Then, allow this to dry.
- 103 4. Finally, put some glue on the thinnest end of  
111 your new wand and dip it in some  
115 biodegradable glitter to decorate.
- 124 5. Allow your wand time to dry completely and  
129 then it's ready to use.
