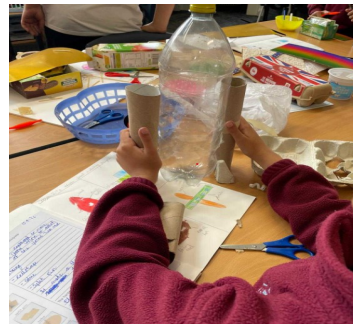
Nursery
